Doug and his father, Steve, operate a cow/calf and contract grazing operation in Northern Missouri near Newtown. Currently, they run about 500 cows.

They utilize Management-Intensive Grazing and Holistic High Density Grazing to improve soil health, eliminate the need for most purchased fertilizer and limit hay needs to about one bale per cow per winter.

Doug is also the Regional Soil Health Specialist for NRCS.

TOPICS: pasture management basics; rotational grazing; soil & pasture health; extending the grazing season; how to reduce or eliminate feeding hay and more...

Jamie Hostetler, Local Jackson County Beef Producer, will also discuss his rotational grazing and watering system and what Regenerative Grazing means to him.
